STRUCTURE OF THE PROJECT FILE

Your project file follow this specific sequence:

1. Cover Page: Title of the project, Student Names, Roll Numbers, Class/Section, and Academic Year.

Acknowledgement: Thanking your teacher, and partner for their support.

3. Certificate of Authenticity: A formal statement stating that this is your original work.

Index: Clearly marked topics with page numbers

5. Main Body Content: (As per the guidelines given in the topics above).

Pro Tip: Use the blank side of your sheets to paste relevant newspaper clippings, graphs, data tables, diagrams, or pictures to make your file visually appealing

Conclusion: A brief summary of your learnings and personal opinion/suggestions on the topic

Bibliography: Mention the sources used (Books, Websites, Economic Journals, Newspapers)

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Your project will be marked on the following parameters:

Relevance and research of the content (Data accuracy) 2.

Presentation, neatness, and creativity

Teamwork and coordination between the partners

Viva-Voce (Oral questions based on the project after holidays)
